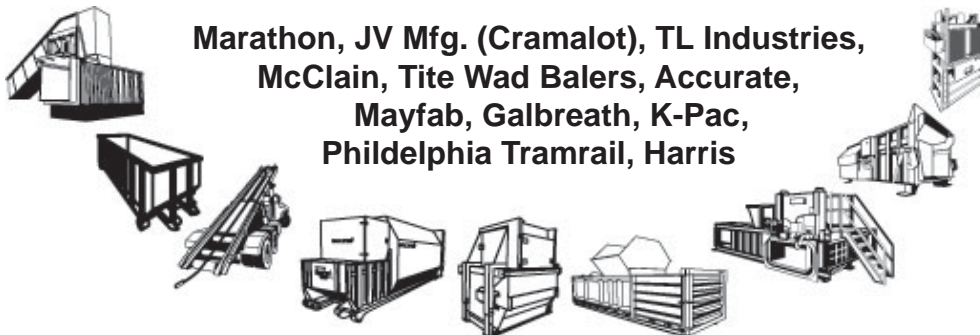
A complete report of their findings is left with the customer detailing operating readings such as amperage, pressures and various temperatures. All preventive maintenance performed is documented.

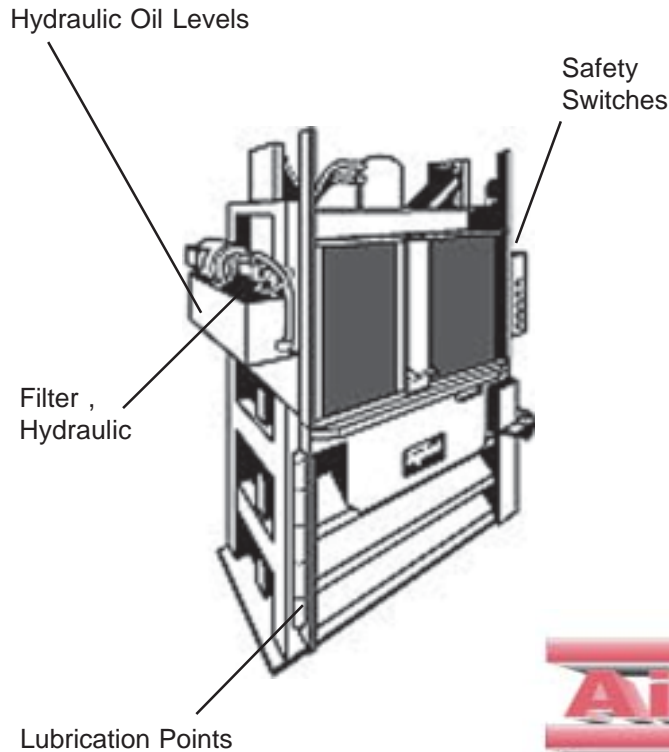
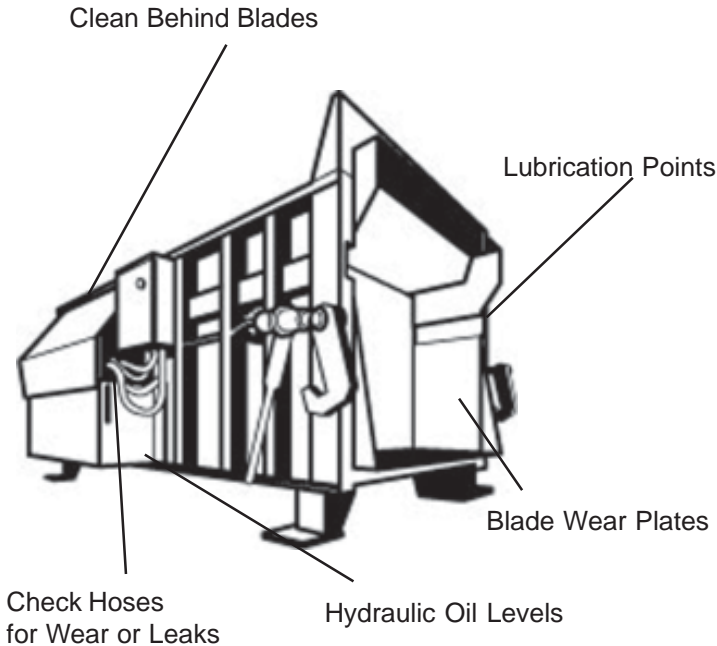

What is a maintenance agreement?
